

## Uniform

Our school uniform is a visual symbol of who and what we are to the people of our community. The wearing of our uniform demonstrates pride in our school and is an advertisement for our school community.

### Procedures:

- The School Uniform Policy is given out to parents when they enrol in the school and sent out at the beginning of the year so that all parents are continually informed about what is required.
- Students are required to wear the full uniform as outlined in the policy each day. The uniform is to be worn and kept neat and clean. All clothing must be labelled with the child's name.
- The uniform consists of a standard full uniform and a separate sports uniform. Parents will be notified as to which days for each class at the beginning of each year.
- Staff members will check uniforms each day to make sure students are wearing the correct uniform in a neat and tidy manner.
- If students are unable to wear the correct uniform, or any part of it, they require an email to their Class teacher from parents explaining the reasons why.
- Parents of students, who are wearing the incorrect uniform, or any part of it, will be sent an email from their class teacher outlining what is incorrect.
- If there is a period of time where a child is unable to wear the uniform, this will be considered on an individual basis, in consultation with the Principal.

**Hair:** Students are to present themselves well-groomed at all times. This shows pride in their own appearance and in their school uniform. Therefore:

- Extreme hair styles are not permitted. These include Mohawks, rat tails, tracks, shaved or number one cuts and colouring of hair.
- Hair is to be brushed or combed neatly when attending school.
- Hair accessories must be school colours (bottle green, sports green, white or uniform check). Acceptable hair accessories are as follows: plain head band; plain scrunchie; ribbon; plain clips or hair bands that are school colours or blend with the hair.
- For safety reasons and to minimise the spread of head lice: Hair below collar length for both boys and girls must be tied back at all times. • Hair that falls across the face or eyes must be tied or clipped back at all times.

**Jewellery:** Jewellery is not an accepted part of the uniform.

- Only a chain with a religious medal or cross may be worn inside the shirt or dress.
- Plain gold or silver (studs or sleepers only) may be worn in both ears, one earring in each ear.
- Children may also wear a signet ring.
- Plain digital or analogue watches may be worn. Make Up: • Make – Up, including nail polish is not permitted.

**Year 6 Leadership Shirt:** This is offered to Year 6 students to purchase and wear on Sports days.

<p>Winter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bottle green jumper. (This can be worn with the formal uniform and the sports uniform)</li> <li>• Optional items: Track suit pants, green tights (not stockings), scarf and gloves in school colours may be worn.</li> </ul>	<p>Winter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bottle green jumper (This can be worn with the formal uniform and the sports uniform)</li> <li>• Optional items: Winter Jacket (ordered separately via School), Track suit pants, green tights (not stockings), scarf and gloves in school colours may be worn. Tracksuits pants are not permitted to be worn with the formal school dress.</li> </ul>
<p>Prep</p> <p>Prep students wear the prep uniform every day. The students wear a green prep polo shirt with All Saints logo on chest and “All Saints Prep” Collar. Boys can wear green sports shorts with logo or plain bottle green shorts. Girls can choose between the green sports shorts with logo, plain bottle green shorts or the school skort with logo. They must wear ALL black leather shoes and white plain crew socks (above ankle height).</p>	
<p>School Hats</p> <p>The All Saints green hat with the school logo screen printed on the front panel or the sports bucket hat must be worn each day. It is strongly recommended that the hat be embroidered with the child’s name/initials. <b>Parents and caregivers can choose which hat they would like their child to wear.</b></p>	
<p>School Bag</p> <p>The green All Saints School Bag with logo is to be used for the duration of schooling at All Saints. It is strongly recommended that the bag be embroidered with the child’s name/initials.</p>
